In principle, the complainant should disclose their name and report the misconduct in a written document, by telephone, fax, e-mail, or in person, clearly indicating the following information. (Anonymous reports may be accepted depending on the content of the report.)

- (1) Name of the researcher suspected of having committed the misconduct
- (2) The nature of the misconduct and the details of the case
- (3) Scientific and rational grounds to consider that it was misconduct.
