With the aim of fostering the future research leaders with both strong research skills and mindset, this program provides young researchers with the mid- to long-term opportunity to conduct research abroad to advance their research, build international networks and become part of prominent scientific communities that will benefit them in their future careers.

Support

① **Financial Support** for Overseas Training [Amount: Max. 6 million yen] [Duration: 3 fiscal years including FY2023]

For expenses necessary for Overseas Training Plan (Must stay at an outstanding overseas research institution and conduct research for 180 days)

② **Opportunities** for skill development & researcher exchanges (tentative) [Duration: 5 fiscal years including FY2023]

Provide opportunities for those who wish to participate in faculty training programs conducted by the implementing institutions of JST Researcher+, Dispatch to a prominent international forum, invite to IAS's social events for researchers

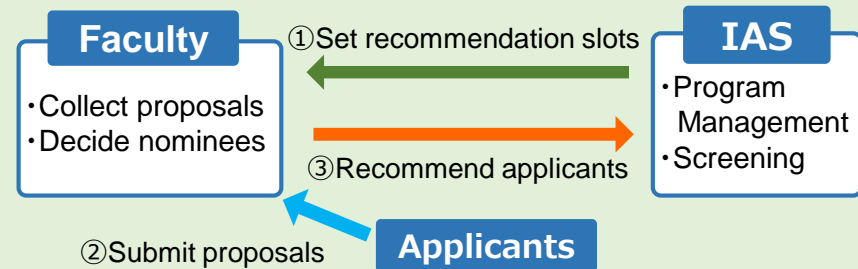
Eligibility

Faculty members who are under 40 years old as of March 31, 2024, or within 10 years of obtaining a doctoral degree*1 and whose position is Associate Professor or below, and who meet one of the following conditions.

- Faculty members hired for a permanent contract
- Tenure-track faculty members

Application

Must obtain the recommendation by the Dean of faculty



Recommendation by Faculty

- The Institute for Advanced Study sets the number of recommendation slots (1 to 4) for each Faculty
- Each Faculty recommends promising young researchers who will lead the future of the faculty to IAS, and supports the implementation of the overseas training if their proposals were accepted

No. of proposals to be accepted

Up to 5 per year

*scheduled to continue until the 5th year (open call for applications in FY2027), supporting 25 researchers in total
