Prof. Shinichi Yamamoto, Dr. Agr.

Director of Research Department

National Institution for Academic Degrees and Quality Enhancement of Higher Education



Prof. Yamamoto fulfills the functions of executive advisor to Okayama University, Visiting Professor to the National Institution for Academic Degrees and Quality Enhancement of Higher Education, Visiting Professor to the National Institutes of Natural Sciences and is Professor Emeritus of Okayama University and of Nagoya University.

In this lecture, Prof. Yamamoto will give a lecture on the history of the research administration system introduced in Japan, the current research administrator's activities, and discuss the vision of the research administration system.

Christine Chang, PhD

US Research Funding Specialist, Karolinska Institute



Christine Chang serves as US Funding Specialist at the Grants Office at Karolinksa Institute. She gives advice to university researchers and administrators on administration, finance and formulation of the application.

In this lecture Christine Chang will share her experience in preparing applications for international funding such as US funding from pre-award perspective and post-award perspective.

Vice President for Research, University of Maryland Baltimore County (UMBC)



Dr. Karl V. Steiner serves as the Vice President for Research and holds the academic rank of Professor in the Department of Mechanical Engineering and an affiliate appointment as Professor in the Department of Computer Science and Electrical Engineering at the University of Maryland, Baltimore County.

In this presentation, Prof. Steiner will share his experience serving in leadership roles to secure externally funded programs for research and infrastructure programs supporting institutional, statewide and regional initiatives.

Monique O'Callaghan

Director Research Development (MDHS), Melbourne University



Ms. O'Callaghan has more than 17 years of experience in the research management profession in a number of roles at the University of Melbourne, spanning both central and faculty administrative positions. Her current role is as Director, Research Development in the Faculty of Medicine, Dentistry and Health Sciences (MDHS).

In this lecture, Ms. O'Callaghan will talk about the use of analytics in deciding research strategy for the university, monitoring the research performance of the university and how analytics can be used in deciding what funding should be acquired.

Kathleen A. Hayes-Ozello

Proposal Development Specialist, Ohio State University



As the college grants specialist and research administrator, Hayes-Ozello is in charge of obtaining and processing funding provided by the National Institutes of Health, submitting 50-70 grants annually and managing a portfolio of more than \$11 million in research expenditures.

Ms. Hayes-Ozello will share her experience in developing multidisciplinary projects with the aim of acquiring funding.
